Right to Education: University of Maryland

We partnered with a PhD scholar from University of Maryland to study the impact of the **Right to Education** on the Economically Weaker Sections quota of underprivileged students, admitted to private schools in Delhi, India.

The aim of the study was to capture the impact of the quota on the mothers of the children. The impact evaluation around the spillover benefits of the RTE would be a step towards informing the debate on the effectiveness of the scheme.



Gender Gaps: Fluent Research with Girl Rising

Outline India is setting up for the midline phase of the ENGAGE program. ENGAGE translates to *Empowering Next Generations to Advance Girls' Education*. The study undertaken by 10X10 Girl Rising with Save the Children as the intervention partner.
