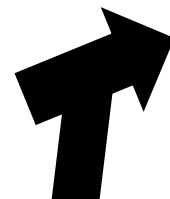


- 4.1 Completion of free, equitable and quality primary and secondary education with relevant and effective learning outcomes, both sexes

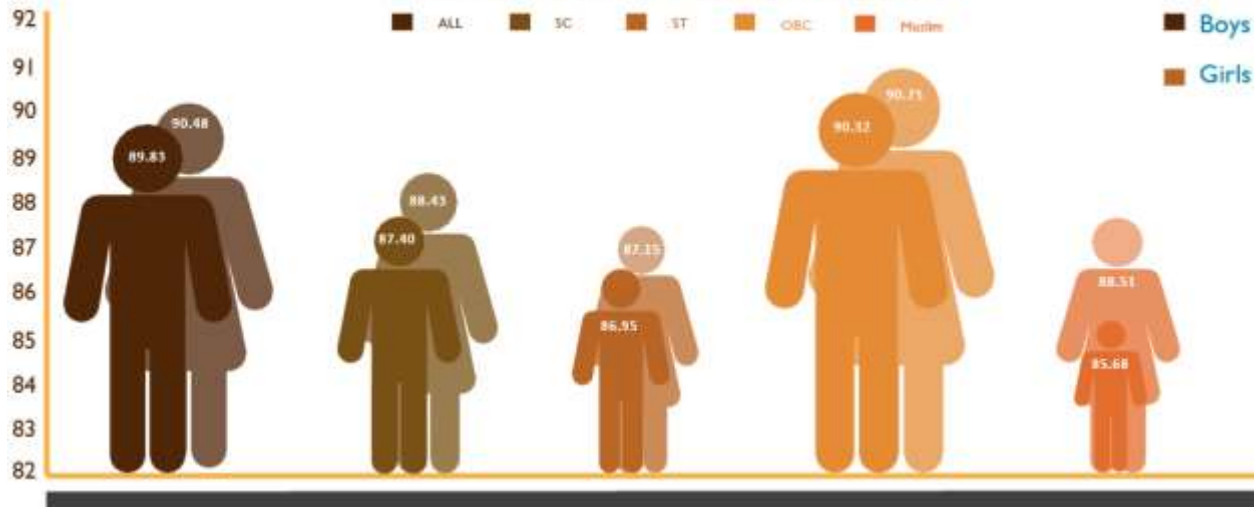

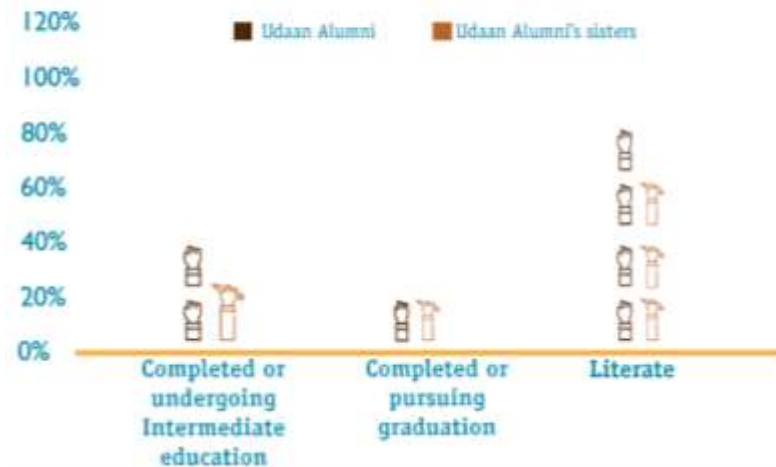

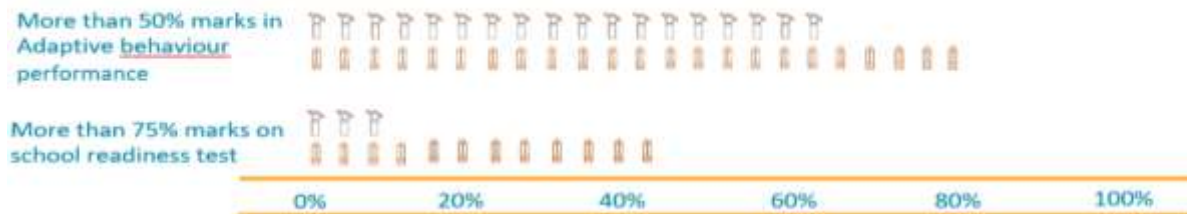
Transition Rate at Primary to Upper Primary by Caste: 2014-15
