### Improving the quality of primary schools through teacher training

STIR Education, in collaboration with New York University, commissioned Outline India to undertake data collection in primary schools in Karnataka. The chief objective of this 3 year RCT programme is to develop measures that can improve primary education through teacher training. Outline India conducted teacher surveys and student assessments across public schools in Ramnagara districts of Karnataka.



### Education, investment and marriage choices among urban males

Outline India is currently working with researchers from the University of Pennsylvania, University of Toronto, and the University of Chicago to understand the relationship between education and marriage investments among urban males in India. The study seeks to provide evidence on how parents' investment in their son's education is related to returns from his marriage. Outline India did extensive research to design, pilot and conduct the surveys.



### Impact Assessment report for a leading NGO

Outline India has been commissioned to develop a summative report to summarise the direction and learning from evaluations conducted in the past 4 years to inform the work of a leading not for profit. The organization works extensively in sectors of Health, Livelihood, Education, Disaster Management and Gender-based violence. We conducted a systematic review of over 25 projects and 75 reports to identify, analyze and synthesize impact and outcome of the organization.
