This September, our team’s work spanned from the Sundarbans to villages and towns across India. We began baseline assessments under the SUNDAR-BAY Project, capturing community voices on livelihoods, ecosystems, and governance to guide cooperation and restoration.

We also evaluated Milaan’s *Girl Icon Program* across three states, engaging 300+ adolescent girls. The program is building leadership, confidence, and agency, with Peer Group Meetings emerging as safe spaces - while also revealing opportunities for stronger community and alumni engagement.

Alongside, we continued our work on employability with the Wadhvani Skills Network and on women’s entrepreneurship with Singer’s sewing machine initiative. Across all projects, our mission stays the same - turning voices from the ground into insights that spark change.

**Location : Sundarbans region
- India (West Bengal) and
Bangladesh**

As part of the **SUNDAR-BAY Project (Strengthening Regional Cooperation and Sustainable Financing for Ecosystem Management and Restoration in the Bay of Bengal)**, Outline India has partnered with **GRET** under a **GiZ**-supported initiative to assess community livelihoods, ecosystem dependencies, and governance dynamics in the Sundarbans. The project supports the development of community-based natural resource management rules and generates evidence on outcomes and impacts to guide adaptive management. Outline India is conducting baseline and endline field assessments in India, including household surveys, key informant interviews, and focus group discussions. The study documents community perceptions on livelihoods, skilling needs, and participation in local planning, while also tracking changes over time. Findings will contribute to a robust evidence base for regional cooperation, ecosystem restoration, and policy design across India and Bangladesh.



**Location : Delhi, Bangalore,
Noida, Nagpur**

The Wadhvani Skills Network's Incremental Placement Study, led by the Wadhvani Foundation, is a flagship program evaluating the impact of its Employability Program (EP) on placement outcomes across Delhi and other Hindi-speaking regions. With a sample of **3,000–4,000**, the study uses a mixed-methods approach to assess the incremental impact by comparing treatment and control groups across partner institutions. It also explores factors influencing employability, offering insights to refine and scale the program.

Outline India is supporting Wadhvani with **tool development, sampling, recruitment and training of enumerators, data collection, quality checks, analysis, and report writing.**



Location : Uttar Pradesh,
Madhya Pradesh and
Karnataka

Outline India conducted a **process evaluation** of the Girl Icon Program across Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, and Karnataka, engaging over 300 adolescent girls and their ecosystems through **surveys, interviews, and observations**. The study found the program effectively builds leadership, confidence, and agency among girls, with Social Action Projects tackling issues like child marriage, menstruation, and school dropouts. **Peer Group Meetings emerged as safe spaces for learning and voice**. The evaluation also identified operational gaps and recommended greater flexibility in design, stronger community and male engagement, and alumni involvement to sustain impact.

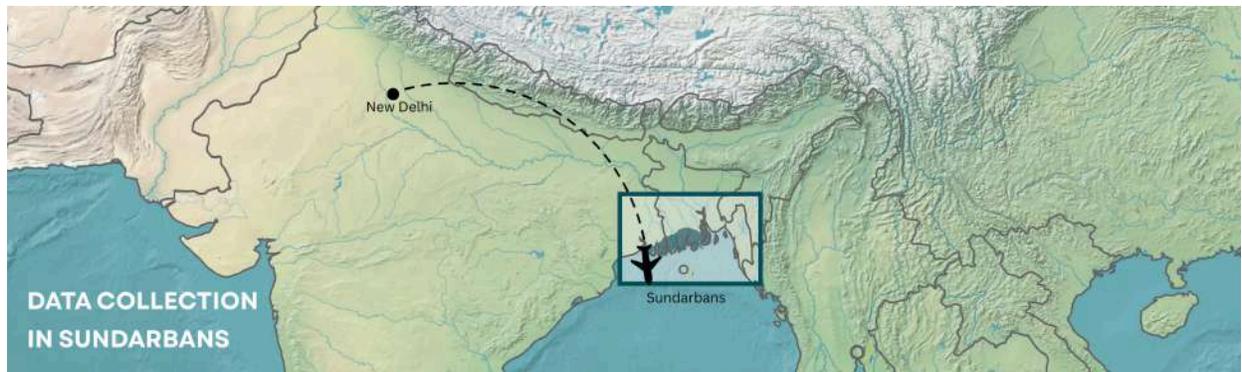

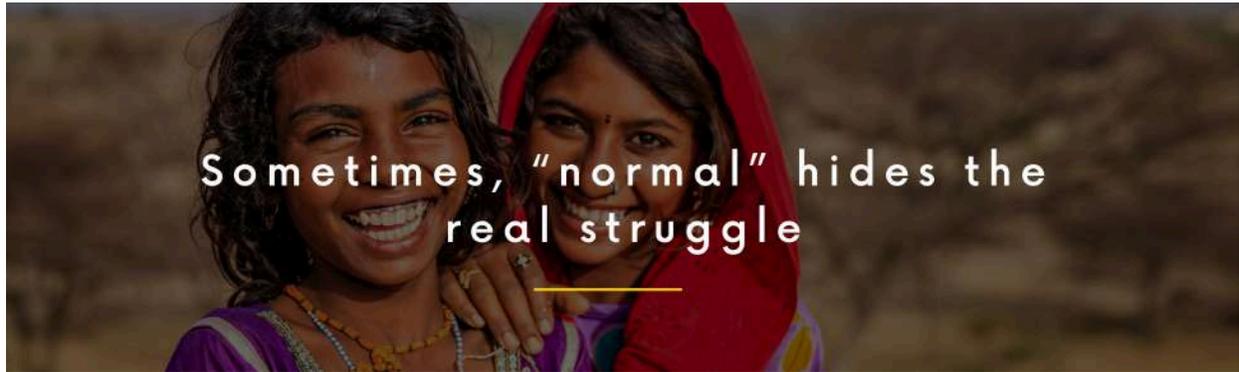
