Outline India, in collaboration with, **The Bridgespan Group**, carried out a research to understand the **medicine buying behavior and the preferences of those suffering from chronic illnesses**, at pharmacies. The research explored consumer and market behavior concerning awareness about generic medicines, along with a special focus on the customer experience. The study delved into understanding the multiple factors influencing customer choices and satisfaction, especially for those dealing with non-communicable diseases and chronic illnesses. The study was conducted in the Anand and Ahmedabad districts of Gujarat, where qualitative interviews were carried out with urban-dwelling consumers above the age of 45.



Outline India is undertaking a study to comprehend the well-being of women in the Jaunpur district of Uttar Pradesh. The study encompasses various aspects, including health, education, marriage, household roles, responsibilities, and relationships, and aims to engage with around 4000 pairs of co-residing Mothers-in-Law and Daughters-in-Law across 60-80 villages. The primary objective is to offer valuable insights to the government for improving the provision of public goods and services for women within the community.










## 10 days of extensive field training in office

## Ol Capability - 01

Village level mapping - helps us to better understand distances, cluster divides, landmarks (temples, govt offices, community centers), to ensure no lane/area or community is missed. Be it require a household listing exercise. This means that we must visit each household, speak to everyone, and get basic demographic details in or engaging with the community people using participatory techniques like focus group discussions.
